# Portillo Malbec, Uco Valley, Mendoza

A gem of a wine from the foothills of the Andes, fresh and fruity on the nose, enhanced by hints of plums, black berries and a touch of vanilla.

#### Cotes du Rhone, Pavillion Saint Pierre, Maison Bouchon, France

A blend, dominated by Grenache, shows notes of red fruit and soft spice. Red fruit is dominant with a touch peppery hedgerow fruit on a soft, ripe palate.

#### Vina Real Rioja Crianza, Spain

A ripe and richly fruity wine with rich aromas of fruitcake and spice. Smooth and supple in the mouth with perfectly integrated oak. A rounded silky texture and smooth tannins, all supported by a lovely weight of fruit.

#### Willi Opitz Blaufränkisch, Burgenland, Austria

The Braunfränkisch grape variety performs well on the clay and sandy soils of Burgenland. Its thick skin allows for a long ripening period particularly in rainy Autumns. Shows black cherry and other ripe, dark fruits with notes of black pepper spice.

#### Mas Janeil, Cotes du Rousillion, France

Organic and sulphur free, this wine is mature on the palate with a fine balance between well-integrated tannins and freshness. Dark garnet colour, boasting red and black fruits with a hint of cherry jam.

# Passori Rossco Vento, Italy

A rich fruity wine with added notes of spice and vanilla which comes from a period of oak ageing. Made in a ripasso style, hence the name, from late harvested Merlot and Corvina grapes which have dried on the vine. Once tried you will not be disappointed. Promise.

# Château du Seuil, Graves Rouge, France

Bottle-£37.95 The wine is aged for about 18 months in French oak barrels- 305 of which are new. A elegant and concentrated, fruity wine with integrated oak flavours.

### Hochar Père et Fils Red, Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

Bottle-£42.95 Predominantly based on a single vineyard near the village of Aana. The soils here Are deeper, over limestone and the age of vines are about 3 years. A blend of Cinsault Grenache, Carignan and Cabernet Sauvignon. Ages for 6-9 months in French Nevers barrels this wine is intense with a complex nose of black and red fruits, figs, dates and spice. The palate shows red and black cherry, blackcurrant and damson fruit with fine tannins and long finish.
