### **Pinot Grigio, Organic Vinuva, Italy**

These grapes are grown without the use of man-made pesticides or fertilisers. Hats off to Sicily for achieving this ripe, delicately flavoured and dare we say "Healthy" wine.

### **Élevé Marsanne- Viognier, Pays d'Oc, France**

Two Rhône varieties completely at home in the warm d'Oc region of southern France. This unoaked wine shows a fresh, floral character with notes of peach and a soft but slightly spicy finish.

### **Errazuriz 1870 Penuelas Block Sauvignon Blanc, Chile**

These grapes are sourced close to the Penuelas Lake between the Pacific and Casablanca Valley, delicious and easy drinking.

### **Trivento Reserve Chardonnay, Mendoza, Argentina**

Made from 100% Chardonnay grown in the Tupungato sub-region of Mendoza. The grapes are handpicked and undergo a cool-fermentation 30% in French oak barrels. This wine shows aromas of ripe fruit, especially white peach and red apple, with subtle notes of asparagus.

### **Pulpo Albarino, Rias Baixas, Spain**

Pure Albarino grape grown in the Salnes Valley region of Rias Baixas close to the town of Cambos, on undulating hills, the vineyards are planted in rocky and alluvial soils which benefit from the influence of the nearby Atlantic Ocean. Unoaked, hints of peach and apricot and a fresh fruity palate

### **Picpoul de Pinet, Les Girles, Jean- Luc Colombo, France**

The village of Pinet is built on a limestone plateau just a few miles from the Mediterranean and the port of Sète, close to the regions oyster beds. The Picpoul grapes are grown around the village and surrounded by pine forests. A rich mouth-filling wine with notes of fresh flowers, ripe summer stone fruit and melon.

### **Te Awa Left Field Sauvignon Blanc, Nelson, New Zealand**

A blend of 91% Sauvignon Blanc from Nelson and 9% from Waipara further South on the South Island. Strongly aromatic with a crisp vibrancy to the finish: it shows aromas of passion fruit, nectarine and lemon grass.

### **Viña Real Rioja Blanco, Barrel Fermented, Spain**

Beautifully balanced and delicious with pure floral and citrus aromas leading to a fat rounded, creamy rich palate. This is a balance by clean cut of grapefruit acidity and subtle toasty biscuit flavours achieved from being fermented in American Oak barrels.

### **Bourgogne Chardonnay Couvent des Jacobins, Louis Jadot, France**

A fine wine from the Cote d'Or. One-third of the wine is barrel-fermented while the balance is fermented in stainless steel. Beautifully balanced wine with a touch of tropical fruit and vanilla on the palate.
