

Rosé

Wicked Lady Zinfandel, California, USA

Medium- sweet rosé made using Zinfandel grapes from warm Californian vineyards. The juice from crushed grapes spends a short time in contact with the skins which gives the wine its salmon pink colour. Shows red-fruits on a rich and juicy palate.

Mirabeau Rose Cotes de Provence, France

Mostly Grenache with Syrah and Cinsault grape. Made by the 'vin de pressurage' method, the red grapes are gently pressed so that just enough colour and flavor is extracted before the juice is separated from the skins for fermentation. Rose-pink with wild strawberry, raspberry and redcurrant aromas.

Chateau Minuty Rose et Or, Cotes de Provence, France

A blend of hand-harvested Grenache and Tibouren grapes, free from herbicides. This delightful Rose shows citrus fruits on the nose and a palate of pink grapefruit and white peach. Perfect with shellfish.

Sparklers

Da Luca Prosecco, Italy

Classic example of the Glera grape grown in the Prosecco Region. Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate.

Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut, France

Bollinger, the family run house fiercely guards its traditions. The full-bodied style results from the Pinot-dominated blend, the majority of which uses grapes from the Grand Cru village of Aÿ.

Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut, France

Made unusually using 100% Pinot Noir grapes from Grand Cue villages. The grapes are allowed only 3 days brief contact with the skins to give the wine its glorious pink colour.
