**Pinot Grigio Col di Sotto, 2016, Italy** 175ml - £4.80  
A delicious, silky white, with pear, apple with notes of honey 250ml - £6.50  
and almond. Easy drinking, refreshing yet delicate. Perfect with fish Bottle - £18.95

**Chardonnay, Alvier, Central Valley, 2017, Chile** 175ml - £5.10  
Light melon and stone fruit flavours with the faintest touch of oaky 250ml - £6.75  
character. Bottle - £19.95

**Sauvignon Blanc, La Poderosa, 2017, Rapel Valley, Chile** 175ml- £5.70  
This wine has a brilliant yellow colour with green hints and aromas of 250ml- £7.30  
lemon fruit and pineapple and has a fresh palate with a rich Bottle- £22.95  
acidity.

**Picpoul de Pinet, Les Jeantels, 2016 Les Vignoble Montagnac, France** Bottle £26.85  
The grapes are always picked prior to 9am to reduce vine stress. A dry  
White with a pale gold colour and fresh orchard fruit aromas leading  
onto a refreshing palate with elegant citrus hints.

**Blanco Rioja, Campillo, Barrel Fermented, 2016, Spain** Bottle £31.95  
Complex floral notes blend with ripe white fruit on a background of well  
integrated wood. Smooth with a touch of acidity.

**Pouilly Fume, Domaine Bonnard, 2016, France** Bottle £33.95  
We are delighted to have secured a parcel of this gem of a Pouilly Fume.  
Lots of fresh, herbaceous fruit with a hint of liquorice on the nose. In the  
mouth, there are delicious Sauvignon Blanc characteristics with citrus and  
gooseberry flavours.

**Sancerre Blanc, Le Chatenai , 2016, France** Bottle £42.95  
Carefully crafted in a classic style, this is a dry and elegant wine, very  
well balanced. Fresh grassy aromas followed by citrus fruit, finishing with  
the pure mineral intensity and zippiness that you'd expect in a classic  
Sancerre.

**Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay, 2017, Marlborough, New Zealand** Bottle £58.00  
Bright, light citrus aromatics of kaffir lime and grapefruit, supported by  
ripe nectarine-like notes. The elegant, concentrated palate reveals juicy  
stone fruit and lemongrass with a lovely minerality and crisp acidity giving  
a long lasting, mouth watering finish.

## Rose

**Pinot Noir, Los Gansos, Cono Sur, Chile** 175ml - £4.80  
This is a lively, but smooth rose, with fresh aromas of strawberries and 250ml - £6.50  
red cherries. Perfect aperitif and pairs well with fish and salads. Bottle - £18.95

**Grenache Cab-Sauvignon, Haut Gleon, Vallee Du Paradis 2015, France** Bottle - £28.95  
A light, round, fruity palate with a long, pleasant aftertaste

## Reds

Black stone fruit and bramble notes with a hint of truffle on the nose. The 250ml - £6.50

- Cabernet Sauvignon, Mountain Range, Concha y Toro 2015, Chile** **175ml - £5.70**  
Berries, Blackcurrents and chocolate with hints of vanilla, ideal with smoked, **250ml -**

- Merlot, Still Bay, 2017, Western Cape, Australia** **Bottle - £24.95**  
Medium-bodied with dark, spicy, rich fruits on the palate, juicy tannins and a hint of oak on a lingering finish.
- Rioja, El Nino de Campillo, 2016, Spain** **Bottle -**  
**£27.95**  
Made from 90% Tempranillo and 10% Graciano. Abundant aromas of ripe red fruit with elegant and well-assembled toasted vanilla notes from the wood. The palate is fresh and balanced with good length and an elegant finish.
- “Zweigelt & Co”, Tinhof Noir, Organic, 2014, Burgenland, Austria** **Bottle -**

Ruby red with violet reflexes, rich and soft, fresh purple aromas, full bodied
- Mas Janeil, Cotes du Roussillon - Villages, 2015, Languedoc, France** **Bottle -**  
**£34.95**  
Sulphur free and wholly Organic. Deep, dark garnet in colour. The nose offers a fanfare of red fruit and cherry jam underscored by floral notes. Very mature on the palate with a fine balance between well-integrated tannins and freshness.
- Merlot, Delice du Prieure Grand Cru, 2011, Saint-Emilion, France** **Bottle -**

Medium-bodied with a touch of oak among the fresh plum notes and soft, easy drinkability. The palate has hints of liquorice, red plum and oak.
